5 day SHORT COURSE

Monday 23rd to Friday 27th November, 2009

Aim

This course facilitates learning that will support participants in reorienting their health setting towards making health promotion part of their core business. Participants will learn about:

- Integrated approaches to health promotion
- Different frameworks for conceptualising a settings approach to health promotion
- Ways in which health services can be reoriented to become more health promoting
- The different approaches to the changes needed to achieve reorientation.

An exciting component of the 2009 program is a one day interactive, invitation-only workshop, included in the cost of course registration. See overleaf for details.

Who should attend the course?

If you have a leadership or support role in health services, the Health Promoting Health Services Short Course is the opportunity for you to develop knowledge, skills and strategies to reorient health settings to be more health promoting.
